

# PARENT BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

## WHO CAN ATTEND?

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Parents with children 6-11 years old who:

- argue,
- refuse to follow directions
- intentionally irritate others
- throw tantrums, or engage in other, similar behaviors more than expected for their age.

## WHEN ARE CLASSES?

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- The Attention and Behavior Clinic is offering an 8-week behavioral management program for parents who struggle to manage their child's behavior at home.
- This program will allow parents to receive weekly coaching via Zoom.
- It will encompass strategies that address positive praise, resolving conflict, and much more.

## WHO WILL YOU WORK WITH?
